Service Electric Cablevision Partners with WeiTel to Complete FCC Proof of Performance Testing and Perform Power Supply Maintenance

ALLENTOWN, PA and KING OF PRUSSIA, PA – JUNE 26th 2008 – Service Electric Cablevision and Weintraub Telecomm, LLC (WeiTel) have united to complete annual FCC mandated Proof of Performance Testing for Service Electric Cablevision and perform on-going preventive maintenance on their power supplies throughout Pennsylvania.

The partnership will create more reliable systems for Service Electric Cablevision and its customers, as well as identifying any problematic areas so that Service Electric Cablevision can meet FCC regulations in a timely manner. As Service Electric Cablevision continues to roll out state-of-the-art voice, video and data services to their subscribers, WeiTel will maintain the most reliable network possible.

WeiTel won the contract to provide the Proof of Performance Testing for Service Electric Cablevision in the Birdsboro, Hazleton and Sunbury, PA systems. The testing will be performed twice a year and is required by the FCC to ensure that all the systems are in compliance with current regulations. The testing will include both head end and outside plant areas.

This contract requires visiting each power supply twice a year to ensure that power will continue to be supplied to the network in event of an emergency, for example, a power outage. The contract also includes installation and verification of the status monitoring system that provides real time feedback on the condition of the power supplies and their associated batteries.
